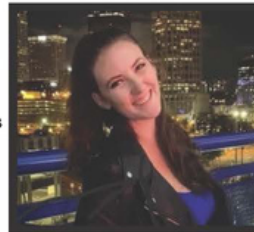

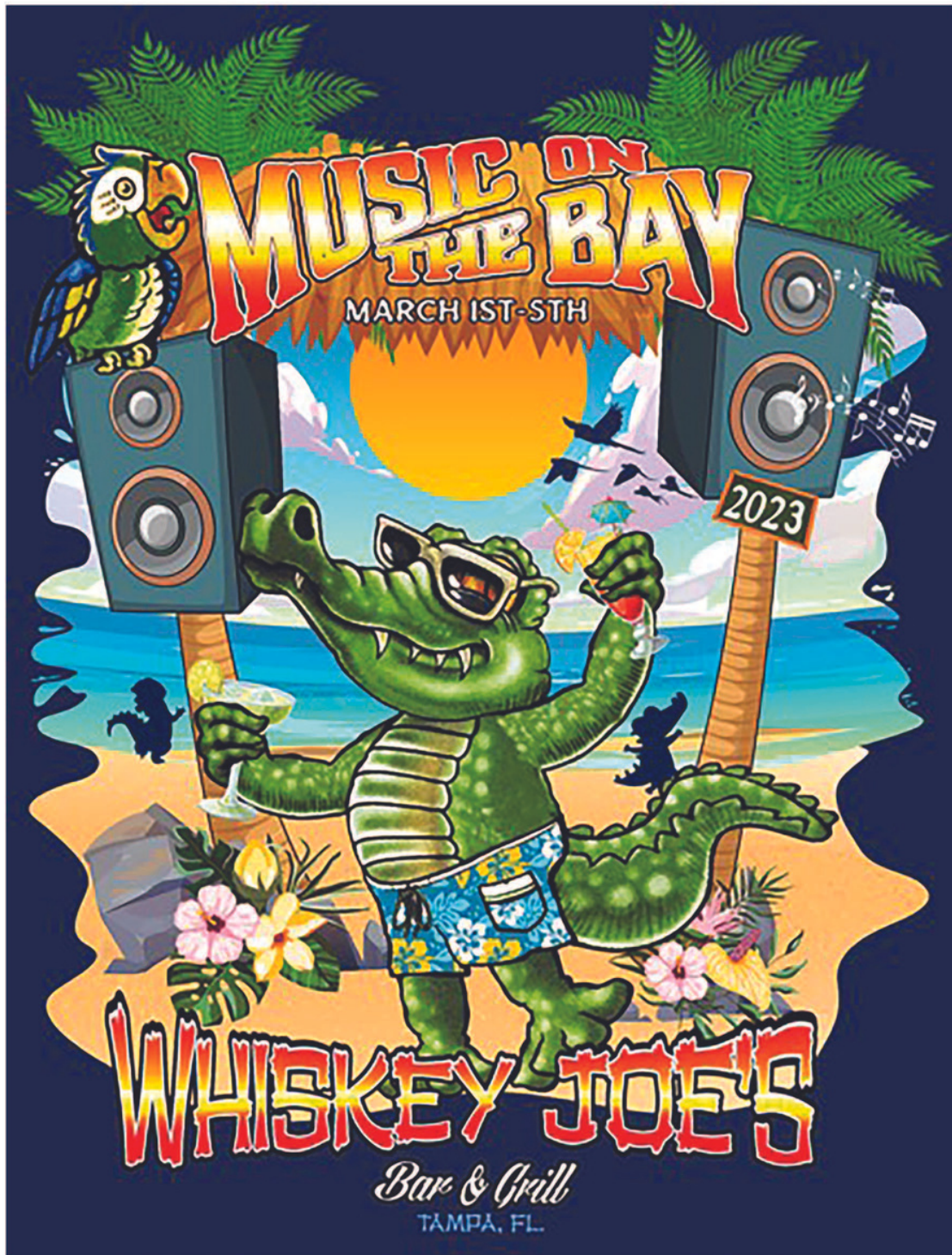

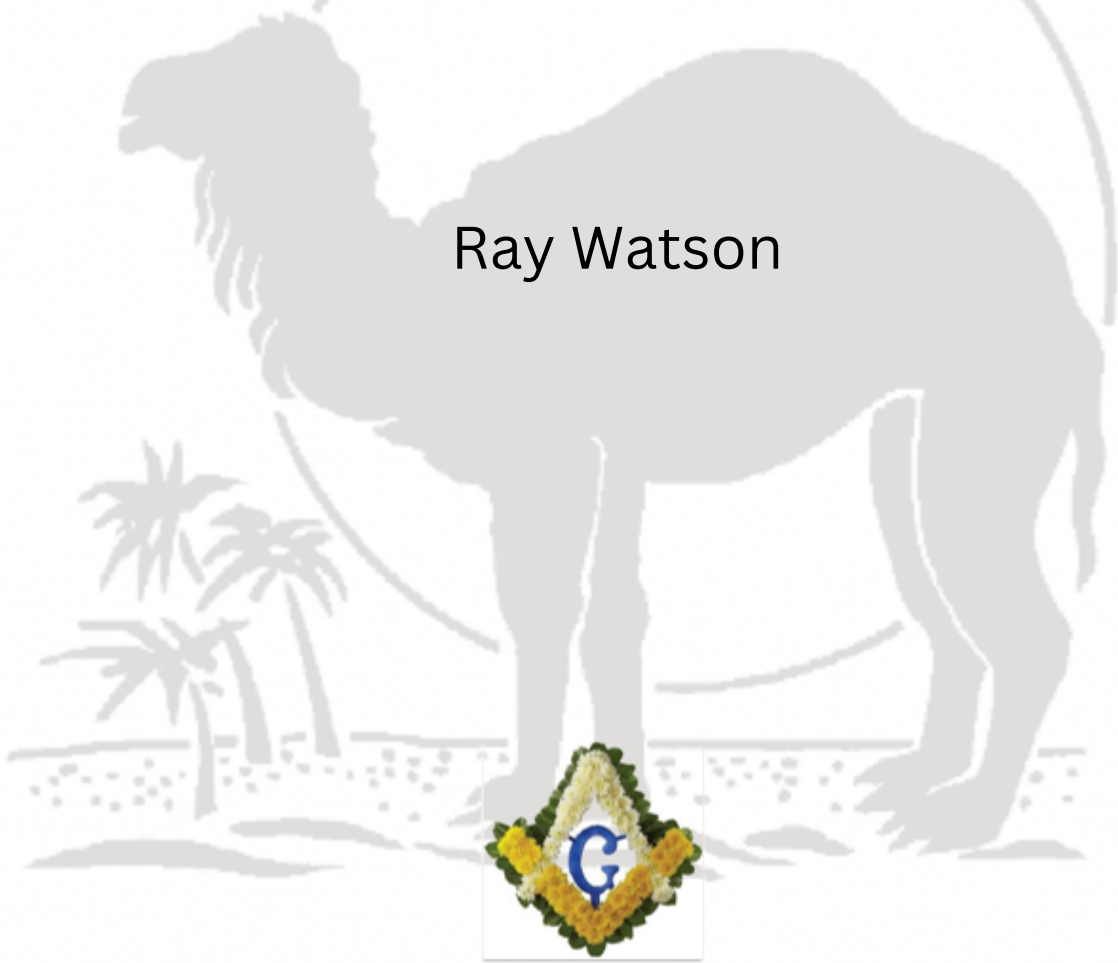

What is the Pull-Tab Program?

The pull-tab program at Egypt Shriners in Tampa Florida was founded Several years ago, and as a way for the public to help raise funds for the humanitarian and lifesaving services provided by Shriners Children's.

These devices – including shoe inserts, braces, and artificial limbs (both arms and legs) – provide the support children need to meet their full potential and pursue their dreams, whether that's swimming in a race, throwing a baseball, playing an instrument, or just keeping up with their friends.

How Can I Help?

You can help by saving aluminum can pull-tabs and bringing them to the Egypt Shrine Center in Tampa with the proceeds going to the POP's Fund. You can also encourage community awareness of the tab program by getting groups such as schools, church groups, boy and girl scouts, family members and businesses in your area to participate.

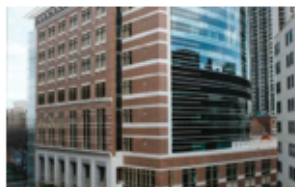

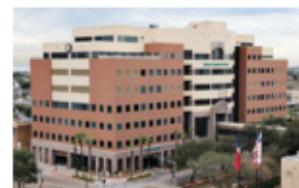

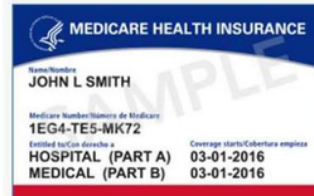
