And last but not least let us remember our tireless and selfless Brother workers and the support of our families that have helped bring us to this point in history.

So I ask you my Brothers remember to pray without ceasing, hug your friends, children, wives, and even that neighbor or brother that you don't agree with because we are all human and we are all in this world together.

These missives regularly attribute the origin of the Entered Apprentice Lecture's instruction about the four cardinal virtues, Fortitude, Prudence, Temperance, and Justice, to Aristotle (384-322 BCE) and Marcus Cicero (106-43 BCE). It is doubtful their works were the only source of our ancient brethren's erudition. There is no shortage of other possibilities.

The philosopher and theologian Thomas Aquinas (1225-1274 CE) provided definitions and instructions on each virtue, albeit in a different order. He discussed the virtues in a context of addressing good and evil.

Temperance directs action toward only what reason



recognizes as good. Fortitude overcomes obstacles to what reason recognizes as good. Justice frames action for the good of society. The emulation of these three virtues is Prudence – the "practical wisdom" Aristotle spoke of.

The Stoic philosopher Arius Didymus (70 BCE – 10 CE) was an advisor of the Roman Emperor Gaius Octavius (63 BCE – 14 CE). His descriptions of the virtues were straight forward.

Prudence is the knowledge of what must be done. Temperance is the knowledge of what actions are worth pursuing and which are to be avoided. Justice was apportioning each person and situation what is due. (Within this virtue, the Stoics placed piety – giving the gods their due.) Finally, Bravery is knowing what is terrible, what is not and what is neither. Arius contrasted these virtues with stupidity, lack of restraint, injustice, and cowardice.

One of Arius's favored virtues was philoponia, industriousness, "the disposition to accomplish unhesitatingly what is befitting through toil." Masons call this "work" or "labor."

Finally, Arius counseled, "we must focus on the task at hand, and waste not a moment on tasks that are not ours. We must have courage, we must be fair, we must check our emotions, we must, above all, be wise."

Perhaps, our ancient brethren studied the works of Aquinas and Arius, in addition to Aristotle and Cicero.

What is clear from the early inclusion of the four cardinal virtues in Masonic ritual is that the ancients considered their study and application significant for our lives.

The Scottish Rite meets at its Center in Tampa on the 2nd Monday of each month at 7:00 PM, preceded by a 5:45 PM dinner. The 13th degree, Royal Arch of Solomon, will be conferred at our July 12th meeting at 6:10 PM, before the regular meeting.

The Scottish Rite's degrees will next be conferred on October 16th and 23rd, 2021. Petitions are available at http://tampascottishrite.org.

The writer is the sitting Master of Tuscan Lodge No. 6 in Bartow, Florida. He does not search for ancient (or modern) writings about the cardinal virtues; the writings just keep popping up. He concludes they might be important.


I am happy to say that this past ceremonial was a success for us. We did present the arch degree, it was done a bit differently this last time, but it went well. For the fall


