The degrees of the Ancient and Accepted Scottish Rite and other appendant bodies rich with symbolism and lessons regarding ethical and virtuous conduct. Multiple volumes of philosophical literature supplement these degrees to aid the search for Light and Truth.

Masonic studies can be never-ending, and it is just as well. Being a good Mason (or citizen, father, brother, husband, et. al.) is not a fixed destination - it is a journey. What seemed to matter most to our ancient brethren was not whether rank and title were successfully achieved in life, but what sort of person a man is and is becoming.

All the degrees and literature lead a Mason back to "from whence we came," to the third degree and its Hiramic Legend. It is indeed a legend. As A.E. Waite (1857-1942) in his New Encyclopedia of Freemasonry reminds us "The legend of the Master Builder is the allegory of Masonry. It happens that his figurative story is grounded on the fact of a personality mentioned in the Holy Scripture, but this historical background is... not the essence; the significance is in the allegory and not in any point of history..."

Much effort has been undertaken (and ink spilled) to interpret the Legend as a reference to the execution in 1314 of Jacques de Molay of the Knight Templars, the 1649 execution of King Charles the First of England or to the crucifixion of the Nazarene at the beginning of the common era.

Yet these interpretations speak in terms of some historical event, not as Waite's allegory.

Searching for the allegory, perhaps, starts with recalling that Hiram's station in a Lodge is represented by the pillar Beauty. Plotinus (204-270) in An Essay on the Beautiful described the refining effect of beauty upon the consciousness of man. He held that for man, being the product of his environment, it was "imperative that every person be surrounded by objects which would evoke the highest and noblest sentiments." The aesthetic ideals of architecture, music and art, those physical examples of mental nobility, would produce men of equally noble thought and character.

Numerous ancient mystical systems espoused that the beauty of every physical, visible object is but a symbol of some principle or idea; each is a repository of eternal verity. From this concept, the allegory of Freemasonry arises. The beauty and symmetry of the five orders of architecture are not studied because they are pleasing to the eye (or to construct one), but to discover the secrets and lessons they allegorically conceal.

Hiram Abiff represents Beauty. Lessons gleaned from the symbolism of his pillar (and other elements in the Legend) lead to the development of nobler character.

Substantially every degree in Freemasonry points back to or builds upon the allegory of the Master Builder as Beauty. Our ancient brethren offered Hiram Abiff for emulation.

The Valley of Tampa regularly meets at its Center in Tampa on the 2nd Monday of each month at 7:00 PM, subject to the Grand Master's directives. Dinner is served at 5:45 PM.

Until we have the opportunity to meet again. Enjoy your summer the best you can. Wear your mask.



Our Unit continues to expand and grow to support the Shriners Hospitals for Children and Egypt Shriners. "Es Selamu Aleikum".




### **All Nobles**






