#### **Scottish Rite News**

Freemasonry teaches with the use of symbols, metaphor, myth, legend, and allegory. This missive considers an allegory from classical times, an allegory likely familiar to our ancient brethren.

The "allegory of the cave" is found in Book VII of Plato's The Republic. In a conversation with his student Glaucon, Socrates employs it as a teaching device for Glaucon's (and our) education.

The allegory starts out something like this: we live in a deep cave. The cave has a long entrance stretching upward towards the light that shines into the mouth of the cave. We face the back wall of the cave, so, the mouth of the cave is behind us. We have lived in this cave since childhood, our bodies and heads are chained (at least metaphorically) so we only see the back wall.

As we stare at that wall, images appear. As objects pass by the mouth of the cave their shadow is cast upon the back wall for us to see and consider. Over the course of time, the shadows receive names. One shadow is called a horse, another a bird; another shape is named a triangle. One shadow is designated to be "virtue."

It is sorta like a puppet show. We're not seeing anything real, just the shadow of something, a triangle, a bird, something named Justice. But, since we are chained and know no better, we think the images are real.

By some means or another, we free ourselves from our chains. So, what we do?

We turn around. We turn from the shadows on the back wall and climb towards the light at the mouth of the cave. (If Socrates had included some winding stairs in this part of his allegory, a Mason would feel right at home.) In Latin, the word for turning is conversio from which we get the word conversion. We have had a conversion experience and start searching for light.

When we get close to the mouth of the cave and see some "real"

light – it can be overwhelming. We realize what we thought was real, was a mere shadow or a resemblance.

But our climbing and searching helps us grow more knowledgeable and wiser. We continue.

The allegory of the cave does not end when the mouth of the cave (top of the stairs) is reached. Socrates tells Glaucon he must go back down into the cave. He must help the folks down there with their journey from ignorance to enlightenment. It was his duty to guide them in their search for light.

Socrates told Glaucon he might fail in that endeavor. For he knew, as did our ancient brethren, they might not welcome his insights. Socrates, and our ancient brethren, also knew that each man must make his own decision to turn from shadows and climb toward Light.

We have decided. See you in Lodge.

The writer is a Past Master of Tuscan Lodge No. 6 in Bartow. He is still climbing. He fears Socrates may have rolled over in his grave at this condensed version. Alas, the writer considers brevity to be a virtue; he is not sure that skill was on Socrates' or Plato's lists.


The placement plan is as follows: Using the "Walking tall statue" which faces north:



The deadline for Tree Sponsor applications is November 11th, 2022.

#### Tree Requirements

The value of the tree and prizes are required to be valued at a minimum of \$500.00

Tree Spaces are approximately 7×7 ft. The tree and prizes must fit in the designated area. All trees must be new & artificial (Real trees are not allowed). Only **LED** lighting can be used on trees, and the sponsor must supply a new 50-foot power cord that meets electrical code.

Trees may be any size, up to a maximum height of 8 feet. Keep in mind that smaller trees must be elevated to be visible. We suggest trees of at least 5 feet in height.

The tree sponsor must supply all setup accessories including, but not limited to wire, tape, decorations, hangers, wire ties, etc. Trees must be properly secured and be free standing. No screws, nails, etc. Tree skirting is recommended. An Inventory list of all prizes as well as the total value is required.

#### Prize Requirements

If any item that is displayed is **not included** with your tree, it must be clearly marked as such. Any item not marked will be considered part of the tree package and will be given to the tree winner. Do not attach cash prizes and/or gift cards to the trees. You can use a copy of the gift card, the envelope, play money or paper printed to look like money. Please provide any cash prizes in an envelope marked with the tree number and sponsor name. This envelope will be placed in the Egypt Shrine safe and given to the winner when they pick up their tree. All other items that are not displayed with the tree, but are included in the prize package, must be provided to the Egypt Shrine by Friday Nov.  $25^{\text{th}}$  no later than 5:00 pm. These items will be secured in a locked room until they are claimed by the winners.

#### **Shriners International**

- In 2022, the Shriners International fraternity and the Shriners Hospitals for Children health care system celebrate major milestones.
- 💰 Shriners International is celebrating the 150th anniversary of its founding, which was on September 26, 1872.
- 🔼 Shriners Hospitals for Children is celebrating the 100th anniversary of its founding, on September 16, 1922.
- Shriners International was founded in New York City in 1872 by a group of fun-loving Masons. Master Masons are eligible for membership in the organization, which is based on the fundamentals of Masonry but with the added elements of fun and fellowship.
- Created by Walter M. Fleming, M.D., and actor William J. "Billy" Florence using a Near-east theme that was in vogue at the time, the fraternity was originally named the Ancient Arabic Order of the Nobles of the Mystic Shrine. It still uses Near-eastern symbols, most distinctively the red fez.
- Now known as Shriners International, the fraternity has nearly 200,000 members, and Shriners can be found on six continents. Shriners are known for their good humor, and they love spending time with others who share their interests, whether it be performing in parades or bands, connecting via Zoom for a technology unit or getting together to ride motorcycles, make barbecue or craft beer. The bond of brotherhood that Shriners enjoy also helps them develop personal and professional skills such as communications and leadership.
- In addition to fun and fellowship, Shriners value serving their communities in ways large and small. From hosting charity events to volunteering their time to supporting their official philanthropy, the red-fezzed Shriners are among the most generous and caring men you will ever meet.

#### **Shriners Hospitals for Children**

- Members of Shriners International have always shared a common desire to help those in need. Even in the earliest years of the fraternity, nobles aided victims of catastrophic events and served those less fortunate in their local communities, exhibiting a generous spirit beyond the group's mission of fun and fellowship.
- In the late 1910s, Shriners International took steps to formalize a philanthropic endeavor members could call their own. In 1922, the first Shriners Hospitals for Children opened, in Shreveport, Louisiana, to serve children with orthopedic conditions, particularly those caused by the polio epidemic happening at the time.
- What began as a single hospital is now a unique health care system with locations across the United States, as well as in Mexico and Canada. Outreach programs help the system reach children around the world.






