13-Day Irish Classic Tour Itinerary

Day 1: Dublin City Tour & Pearse Lyons Distillery

Your tour begins at 2:00 PM at your Dublin hotel. Take a panoramic tour of Dublin, seeing such sights as elegant Georgian townhouses, St. Stephen's Green and the River Liffey. Visit the Pearse Lyons Distillery, Dublin's only independent, family-owned distillery, in the former St James's Church in the Liberties. Taste the whiskey and hear tales dating back to the 12th century as you tour this lovingly restored church. Enjoy a welcome drink with your group before dining independently.

Day 2: Down Cathedral, The St Patrick Centre, Crumlin Road Gaol & Belfast
Visit Down Cathedral where St Patrick's historical burial site is marked by a huge boulder. Immerse yourself in his work, life, and times in the nearby St Patrick Centre. Explore Crumlin Road Gaol and see what prison life was like through the ages. Head to central Belfast for some time to relax before dinner at your hotel. (B, D)

Day 3: Titanic Belfast & Belfast Walking Tour

Tour central Belfast to see Victorian buildings, the imposing City Hall in Donegall Square, and the shipyards where RMS Titanic was built in 1912. Visit Titanic Belfast to learn about the ill-fated liner, which was built in the city. In the afternoon, join a local guide for a walking tour of Belfast before spending time on your own. (B)

Day 4: Giant's Causeway, Derry Walking Tour & Walled City Brewery

Drive north along the Nine Glens of Antrim for views of mountains, valleys, and coastline. This scenic region is one of the locations for "Game of Thrones." Stop for photos at the ruins of Dunluce Castle. Explore the Giant's Causeway, enormous hexagonal columns formed by volcanic activity 60 million years ago. In Derry join a local guide for a short walking tour around the defensive walls that encircle the compact old city. Then visit the Walled City Brewery, an award-winning CIE Tours Exclusive venue, for dinner and a flight of their craft beers. (B, D)

Day 5: Westport & Westport Walking Tour

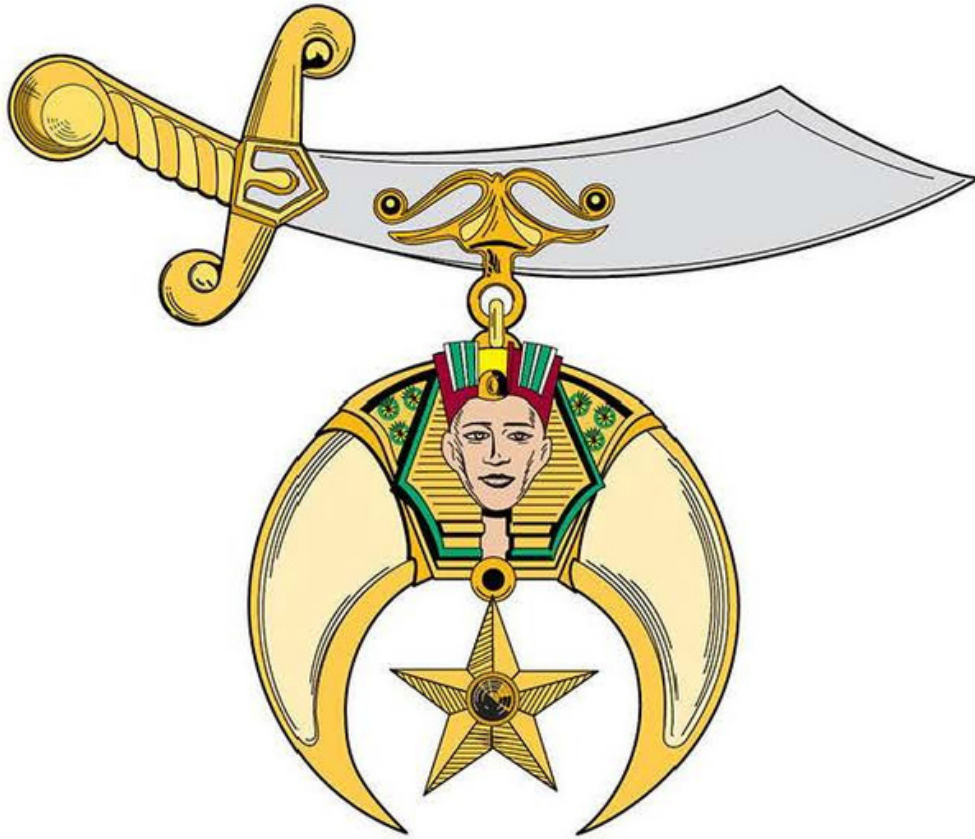

TREE SPONSOR RULES AND GUIDELINES

The Festival of Trees fundraiser is an excellent opportunity for businesses to show their philanthropic support while receiving public recognition for their contribution. This type of event has been hosted by other Shrine organizations around the United States for several years.

Based on our previous events we anticipate between 8,000 and 10,000 people will view the trees in our third year. Our goal is to have 70 trees sponsored this year.

The deadline for Tree Sponsor applications is November 11th,

2022. Tree Requirements

The value of the tree and prizes are required to be valued at a minimum of \$500.00

Tree Spaces are approximately 7x7 ft. The tree and prizes must fit in the designated area. All trees must be new & artificial (Real trees are not allowed). Only **LED** lighting can be used on trees, and the sponsor must supply a new 50-foot power cord that meets electrical code.

Trees may be any size, up to a maximum height of 8 feet. Keep in mind that smaller trees must be elevated to be visible. We suggest trees of at least 5 feet in height.

The tree sponsor must supply all setup accessories including, but not limited to wire, tape, decorations, hangers, wire ties, etc. Trees must be properly secured and be free standing. No screws, nails, etc. Tree skirting is recommended. An Inventory list of all prizes as well as the total value is required.

Prize Requirements

If any item that is displayed is **not included** with your tree, it must be clearly marked as such. Any item not marked will be considered part of the tree package and will be given to the tree winner. Do not attach cash prizes and/or gift cards to the trees. You can use a copy of the gift card, the envelope, play money or paper printed to look like money. Please provide any cash prizes in an envelope marked with the tree number and sponsor name. This envelope will be placed in the Egypt Shrine safe and given to the winner when they pick up their tree. All other items that are not displayed with the tree, but are included in the prize package, must be provided to the Egypt Shrine by Friday Nov. 25th no later than 5:00 pm. These items will be secured in a locked room until they are claimed by the winners.

What is the Pull-Tab Program?

The pull-tab program at Egypt Shriners in Tampa Florida was founded Several years ago, and as a way for the public to help raise funds for the humanitarian and lifesaving services provided by Shriners Children's.

In Tampa, tabs are collected at Egypt Shrine Center. The tabs are redeemed at a recycling center and the proceeds benefit the Shriners Children's Pediatric Orthotics and Prosthetic Services, LLC (POPS). Donations range from small baggies and containers to hold them.

What is the Shriners Children's Pediatric Orthotics and Prosthetic Services?

Funds generated in the pull-tab program designs, fits, and manufactures orthotics and prosthetics for children, from infants to teenagers to young adults. These devices – including shoe inserts, braces, and artificial limbs (both arms and legs) – provide the support children need to meet their full potential and pursue their dreams, whether that's swimming in a race, throwing a baseball, playing an instrument, or just keeping up with their friends.

How Can I Help?

You can help by saving aluminum can pull-tabs and bringing them to the Egypt Shrine Center in Tampa with the proceeds going to the POP's Fund. You can also encourage community awareness of the tab program by getting groups such as schools, church groups, boy and girl scouts, family members and businesses in your area to participate.
