Freemasonry is an exercise in the study of virtue. We begin early in the Blue Lodge, considering the four cardinal virtues, Fortitude, Temperance, Prudence and Justice and the three theological virtues, Faith, Hope and Charity. Friendship, Morality and Truth are introduced later.

These might be termed "major" virtues. The Scottish Rite continues the exploration of what might be referred to as the "minor" virtues or, better, "foundational" virtues: those character traits that must be developed and acquired to develop the major ones.

Its 29 degrees steadily present lists of desirable and necessary qualities or traits: silence, obedience, fidelity, industriousness, honesty, benevolence, devotion, civility, frankness, disinterestedness; the list is extensive. Indeed, in "Understanding Manhood in America," Illustrious Robert Davis 330 GC, identifies 103 virtues taught in the degrees of Freemasonry.

Aristotle thought humans (like all creatures) were created to perform certain activities or series of actions with their souls, minds and bodies. He defined virtue as the "art of being a good human being."

Aristotle counsels that virtue does not come to us naturally. We must use our rational abilities to identify virtuous action and then practice it until it becomes a habit

George Winfred Hervey (1821-1908), author of "The Principles of Courtesy, with Hints and Observations on Manners and Habits" agrees noting, "...one's own experience is less valuable to him than is commonly supposed. He seldom learns the lesson of experience till it is too late to reduce it practice."

Further Hervey opines that it is an absurd pretention that anyone can "readily master any art without availing himself of the experience of his predecessors." The "art of being virtuous" requires

not only practice (as Aristotle taught), but the consultation with our ancestors through the study of tradition, history, philosophy and religion.

His book focuses on foundational or minor virtues, as does the Scottish Rite. Each of its twentysix chapters focuses one virtue, e.g. meekness, gratitude, deportment, zeal and hospitality.

Hervey teaches us 26 virtues; Freemasonry at least 103. Hervey has us look to our predecessors for knowledge and wisdom, as does the Fraternity. Aristotle would have us learn and practice the "art of being a good human being," until virtue is indeed a habit.

The Valley of Tampa regularly meets at its Center in Tampa on the 2nd Monday of each month. Dinner is served at 5:45 PM and the regular meeting starts at 7:00 PM. At our January 13th meeting, 2020 officers will be installed.

Casey Fletcher is the sitting Master of Tuscan Lodge No. 6 in Bartow, Florida. He considers Hervey's book a difficult read – on a par with Albert Pike's works. He recommends attending the degrees of the Scottish Rite several times before tackling it.




New members are always welcome. This is one way you can support the Shrine.






