#### About the FEZtival of Trees

The festival of trees is a family event that is put on by Egypt Shriners with help from local sponsors that showcase decorated "themed" Christmas trees that are raffled off at the end of the event. The tree, decorations, and any goodies under or around it, are all included as the prize.

Trees entered have a variety of "themes" to them and are only limited by the imagination of the Sponsor. Almost any type of company, group, or organization can be a sponsor for the Feztival. Themes are displayed under your company, group or organization name along with the contents that included with the tree on the raffle box located at each tree.

Tree theme examples could be sports teams, outdoors, or day at the beach. In another Shrine's Feztival of Trees event, a car dealership includes a used car as a prize every year. The car is displayed prominently in the parking lot with the company's name on it!

The public is invited to view the trees during the weekend display periods of Saturday Nov. 13th and Sunday 14th, and the evening of Friday 19th and all-day Saturday and Sunday Nov. 20th and 21st. (Dates and times are subject to change). Admission is \$2.00 per person for ages 13 and above. Children 12 years and under are no charge when accompanied by an adult.

#### **Hours of Operation:**

Saturday, Nov. 13th 9:00 am to 9:00 pm Sunday, Nov. 14th 9:00 am to 6:00 pm Friday, Nov. 19th 2:00 pm to 8:00 pm Saturday, Nov. 20th 9:00 am to 9:00 pm Sunday, Nov. 21st 9:00 am to 5:00 pm

#### **How Tree Winners are Selected:**

Attendees can purchase raffle tickets for \$0.50 per ticket. Raffle tickets are deposited in the container affiliated with the tree you want to win. There is no limit to the number of raffle tickets that can be purchased. Businesses may purchase raffle tickets for their own tree.

One ticket will be drawn as a winner for each tree. That ticket will win the entire tree and the prizes/gifts associated with that tree.

Winners will be contacted by phone immediately following the raffle ticket drawing. The list of winners will also be posted on the Egypt Shrine website. Trees must be picked up by the winners on Monday Nov. 22nd between 9:00 am and 2 pm. Please call the office if alternate arrangements must be made.

In addition, the business or organization that receives the most raffle ticket submissions will be designated as the "Feztival of Trees" Champion and will be recognized for their honor through social media and on the Egypt Shrine website.

#### TREE SPONSOR RULES AND GUIDELINES

The Feztival of Trees fundraiser is an excellent opportunity for businesses to show their philanthropic support while receiving public recognition for their contribution. This type of event has been hosted by other Shrine organizations around the United States for several years.

Based on our previous events we anticipate between 8,000 and 10,000 people will view the trees in our first year. Our goal is to have 70 trees sponsored this year.

#### The deadline for Tree Sponsor applications is November 5th, 2021!

#### **Tree Requirements**

The value of the tree and prizes are required to be valued at a minimum of \$500.00

Tree Spaces are approximately 7×7 ft. The tree and prizes must fit in the designated area. All trees must be new & artificial (Real trees are not allowed). Only **LED** lighting can be used on trees, and the sponsor must supply a new 50-foot power cord that meets electrical code.

Trees may be any size, up to a maximum height of 8 feet. Keep in mind that smaller trees must be elevated to be visible. We suggest trees of at least 5 feet in height.

The tree sponsor must supply all setup accessories including, but not limited to wire, tape, decorations, hangers, wire ties, etc. Trees must be properly secured and be free standing. No screws, nails, etc. Tree skirting is recommended. An Inventory list of all prizes as well as the total value is required.

#### **Prize Requirements**

If any item that is displayed is not included with your tree, it must be clearly marked as such. Any item not marked will be considered part of the tree package and will be given to the tree winner.

Do not attach cash prizes and/or gift cards to the trees. You can use a copy of the gift card, the envelope, play money or paper printed to look like money. Please provide any cash prizes in an envelope marked with the tree number and sponsor name. This envelope will be placed in the Egypt Shrine safe and given to the winner when they pick up their tree. All other items that are not displayed with the tree, but are included in the prize package, must be provided to the Egypt Shrine by Friday Nov. 12th no later than 5:00 pm. These items will be secured in a locked room until they are claimed by the winners.

#### **Setup Dates and hours**

You may set up your tree, make changes and/ or add to your tree during these days and hours.

Thursday November 11th 9:00 am to 9:00 pm Friday November 12th 9:00 am to 5:00 pm

All trees must be set up by 5:00 pm on Friday Nov. 12th or the business forfeits its ability to participate. No raffle prize will be awarded on behalf of the business in the event no tree is displayed.

However, the business will still be responsible for providing a \$500.00 payment to the Egypt Shrine.

A soft opening will be held on Friday, Nov. 12th from 6:00 pm to 8:00 pm for all tree sponsors, families, and their employees.

Egypt Shrine is not responsible for loss or damage to any trees, prizes or displays.







