My Fellow Nobles,

Where has the time gone? Here it is December and the year is almost over, I cannot tell you what an honor and privilege and honor it is and has been to serve you, the Nobility.

All y'all, the Egypt Shrine Nobility, are the best in all of Shrinedom! We were able to purchase a used Silent Messenger statue for less than 50% of what a new would cost. We were a little short in the funds and sent out a request for help. The response is overwhelming. Currently, the total is over \$6000. We raised more than we needed for the statue so all monies above and beyond the cost of the statue and getting it refurbished will be given to the First Lady's fund next year to help build a first-class base. Thank you again for all of your support.



We are framing the walls, putting up the DensGlass, and the building is really taking shape. Be sure to check the website, egyptshrine.org, and Facebook weekly to see the new photos that will be posted as we make progress on the property. This will be our pictorial history of our New Home!

We set out this year with several goals in mind. One of them was the 5-2-2 goal that Imperial has asked us to meet: 5% growth over last year, 2% increase in restorations, and 2% decrease in NPD's. Well I am happy to report that we have exceeded our goals! We needed 58 creations and we are within 1 or 2 of that goal, restorations we needed 12... we currently have 22 - a 220% increase, and for NPD's we needed to reach 98... Well I am happy to report that we are at 93!! We are below 100 in suspensions for the first time in like forever! Thank you to everyone who assisted in meeting these very important goals!

Finally, I want to wish each one of you and your families a very Merry Christmas.

Freemasonry is saturated with symbols, allegories and mysteries. The 32nd degree of the Scottish Rite, Master of the Royal Secret, epitomizes this characterization.

Among its symbols, for which the ceremony offers only teasers as to their meaning, are the seven-pointed star, the pentalpha, the triple-interlaced triangles, the lesser and greater tetractys and the trimurti (three-headed bust).

The ritual, especially the Minister of State's address toward the end of (this long) degree, introduces much in the way of eastern philosophy, quite unfamiliar, including that of the Hindus, Pythagoras, Brahma and others. Much of the instruction focuses on triads or trinities, e.g. Agni, Usha and Mitra, the Hindu trinity symbolized by the tripleinterlaced triangle and, perhaps, the trimurti. All the degree's instruction is intended to lead us toward a path of re-discovering the Real Word, that Word itself being a metaphor for enlightenment.

The (all too brief) explanation of the symbols includes references to the ancients Aryans, Ahura Mazda, the "Zend-Avesta", the "Gathas" and Zoroastrianism.

This missive explores the history of these references.

Zoroaster was a religious leader once thought to have lived in the sixth century BCE; this thought was based on references in Greek and Persian literature of the time. Modern scholarship into Zoroastrian literature, however, places him around 1500 to 1200 BCE; perhaps around the time of Moses of the Abrahamic faiths. The Aryans were an ancient people originating from what is now Iran; they are thought to have migrated and expanded into what is now India.

The "Zend-Avesta" is the sacred text of Zoroastrianism and was written in Sanskrit. It contains seventeen 'Gathas" – prayer hymns thought to have been composed by Zoroaster. The Creator Deity of this belief system was called Ahura Mazda. The history of the religion through the time of Alexander the Great, the rein of various Persian empires and the advance of Muslim armies in the seventh century CE is ripe for study, but too long for a missive such as this. The sum of this history is that Zoroastrianism is at risk of "extinction." It survives in small numbers in India and its adherents are commonly referred to as Parsis.

Scholars suggest Zoroastrianism's basic ideas were influential to the Abrahamic faiths and Hindu belief systems.

A French translation of the "Zend-Avesta" was first available in 1771; its timing is such that it may have been available to Albert Pike, who was a bibliophile, knowledgeable of French and author of the Scottish Rite degrees.

Zoroastrianism may have been one of the earliest monotheistic belief systems, although it appears to contain elements of dualism. A modern scholar, Mary Boyce, considers it "the oldest of the revealed credal religions." The "Zend-Avesta" records the search for divine knowledge; it is complex. The "Gathas" are rich with allegory and metaphor. The axiom "good thoughts, good words, good deeds" originates from the "Gathas." That is a pretty good triad.

The 32nd degree imparts a lot of such "ancient" thoughts and ideas.

As Scottish Rite Masons, among our tasks and duties, we are to rediscover that what has been lost – the mysteries and concepts hidden in the symbols of the ancients, including Pythagoras, the Hindu and Brahims and Zoroaster. All that we seek to learn and re-discover is not hidden in the works of Plato or in western philosophy (or modern media). The 32nd degree reinforces this notion.

Inquiry beyond our zeitgeist worldviews is commended. Our pursuit for instruction and enlightenment can only be pierced by our own efforts. Knowledge and enlightenment are hidden in the symbols, allegories and mysteries of many ancient traditions. The 32nd degree reinforces this notion also.

The Valley of Tampa regularly meets at its Center in Tampa on the 2nd Monday of each month. Dinner is served at 5:45 PM and the regular meeting starts at 7:00 PM. At our December 11, 2019 meeting an educational program will be presented (probably on this topic).


And we don't forget our main goal of supporting our



INTERNATIONAL BYLAWS CHANGES

325.2 Election and Qualification.

(a) **Election Order**. The first 7 officers shall be elected annually, in the order in which they appear in 325.1 (a), by ballot and constitute the official divan. Candidates for elective office in a temple must be members in good standing of that temple.

325.10 Representatives.

- (a) Single Ballot. Where a temple elects more than one Representative, all candidates must be balloted for on one written ballot.
- (b) Complete Ballot. Each member voting must vote only for the total number of Representatives to be elected, otherwise his ballot cannot be counted as a vote.
- (c) Majority Vote. A majority vote of those present and voting is necessary to elect each Representative.
 - (d) **Election**. Only those candidates who receive a majority vote shall be declared elected.
- (e) Successive Ballots. Successive written ballots must then be taken in the same matter on other candidates until all Representatives are elected.
- (f) **Highest Vote**. If more candidates receive a majority vote than the number of Representatives to be elected, then those receiving the greatest number of votes shall be declared elected.
- (g) Void Ballot. Blank ballots or ballots containing any markings other than the name of a candidate nominated from the floor are not votes and are not to be considered for any purpose.

325.11 Election Regulations.

- (a) **Electioneering**. A candidate for an elected office in a Shrine temple may print, publish and circulate during the year he is seeking the elected office, a resume consisting of his educational background, his vocational history, and his Masonic and Shrine record. Except as provided in the prior sentence, the printing, publication, circulating or distribution of resolutions, letters, telegrams, tickets, email or other devices, by a unit, club, Noble, or group of Nobles, suggesting, recommending, opposing, or containing the names of proposed candidates for office in the temple is prohibited.
- (b) **Expenditures Prohibited**. The expenditure of money for gifts, favors, or entertainment on behalf of a candidate for elected office is prohibited.
- (c) **Violation**. For any violation of (a) or (b), the Imperial Potentate may suspend any offend-

Noble and he may declare the election of the officers' void and order a new election.

(d) **Notice**. At least one week prior to the annual meeting or any election, the temple Recorder

shall mail to each member a notice thereof containing this section.

Oriental Guide Must Be Selected Wisely

When the Members of a Shrine Temple elect a Noble to the Office of Oriental Guide, they are virtually starting that Noble through the Divan Line, on the assumption that he will prove qualified for and worthy of advancement to the high office of Illustrious Potentate.

Hence, it is quite evident that the nomination for Oriental Guide should be based upon through and accurate evaluation of character, ability, prestige, interest and experience.

A Noble can be a good fellow, a hard worker and a loyal Shriner ... and yet lack basic qualifications which make a good Potentate. Unless a Noble is fully qualified for the job, he is unfair both to himself and his Temple in seeking the office or in permitting his fellow Nobles to support and promote his candidacy.

Each Shrine Temple needs and requires able, high-type leadership. The normal staring point of that leadership is the Office of Oriental Guide. The following checklist may prove helpful in evaluating candidates for the Office of Oriental Guide. However, no thinking man would be so naive or presumptuous as to believe that any one Noble could possibly embody all of the virtues, talents and qualifications which are set forth in this checklist, Nevertheless, the list has practical value ... for self-evaluation by the Noble whose ultimate aspiration is the Office of Illustrious Potentate ... and for advance evaluation of potential candidates by the voting members.

- · Executive ability
- Business sense
- Community standing and influence
- Well poised
- · Good Health
- Diplomacy
- · Stage presence
- · Competent organizer and promoter
- Ability to give and get cooperation
- Social grace
- · Financially secure
- · Energy and vitality
- · Free to devote ample time
- Capable of building good public and Masonic relations
- Good habits and moral character
- Interest in the Shrine and Masonry in total
- Capable of delegating responsibility
- Understanding beforehand with wife and family.

Many Temples have placed definite limitations upon their progress and standing in the community as a result of hasty, ill-considered judgement in connection with nominations of the Office of Oriental Guide. Every Noble is a good Noble ... but it does not necessarily follow that every Noble is fitted to meet the rigorous demands imposed upon Divan Officers and Potentates.

So let's be fair, honest and wise in the all-important matter of electing to office only men who are eminently qualified for the job! We all know that with honor comes responsibility. And while there is high honor associated with a Divan Office, the ensuing responsibilities entail a lot of time consuming, energy-consuming

POTENTATES'S APPOINTMENTS TERMINATE WITH EXPIRATION OF ILLUSTRIOUS SIR'S TERM

For the information of uninformed Members of the Nobility, when a Potentate's term of office expires, all appointments made by him during his administration terminate.

Such appointments include all Appointed Officers, Potentate's Aides, Ambassadors, Commandant of Units, Members of Committees and their Chairmen, Special Appointees, Directors and Assistant Directors of Shrine Clubs and all Members of the Potentate's Staff.

It has been called to the attention of the Potentate that some uniformed Nobles have mistakenly believed, or assumed their appointments to be permanent.

OWN APPOINTMENTS

Not so. Each POTENTATE, when he is installed in office as CHIEF EXECUTIVE of a Temple of the Mystic Shrine, must make his own appointments, including six officers of the Divan - 1st and 2nd Ceremonial Masters, Director, Marshal Captain of the Guard and Outer Guard.

The POTENTATE has the power and authority under the Imperial Shrine law to replace any appointee; or he may, if he believes it to be in the best interest of the Temple to retain all appointees.

Traditionally, for the sake of efficiency, many Nobles of demonstrated ability are continued in office by reappointment. But this is at the will and pleasure of the incoming Potentate.

IS NOT BOUND

In no case is he, or can he be, bound by his predecessor. By the same token, in no case can any Potentate bind his successor.

Courtesy requires that a Noble holding an appointive office, position or assignment tender his resignation to the incoming Potentate. If it is the will and pleasure of the incoming Potentate that the Noble continue in his office or position by reappointment, he will be notified by the Potentate to that effect.

In the event a Noble is not reappointed for the ensuing year, he should deliver the INSIGNIA or EMBLEM of office to the Recorder. Also, he should deliver the official Fez carrying such lettering as "DIVAN" or any title or committee or staff designated to the Recorder unless he is allowed by the incoming Potentate to keep the official Fez for sentimental reason.

REMOVING LETTERING

If the gift Fez is worn, all lettering except the name of the Temple should be removed.

Should any Noble not holding an appointment by the current Potentate wear a Fez carrying such title as "AIDE" or "AMBASSADOR" or any other designation, he does so in violation of the Imperial Code.

Some title-happy Nobles seek to perpetuate an appointment fictitiously by adding to the lettering on the Fez the year or years of their appointment. This is in violation of Imperial Law. The offenders may be uninformed, but "ignorance of the law is no excuse."

IMPERIAL CODE

For the information of all concerned, quoted in section 110, Article XVI of the Imperial Code: "The Red Turkish Fez with Black Tassel bearing only the name of the Temple of which the Noble is an active Member, with a facsimile of a scimitar and that portion of the jewel of the Order consisting of the crescent, sphinx head, and star combined, embroidered thereon with gold and silver bullion or silk is hereby adopted as the exclusive type of head covering to be worn by all Nobles of the Mystic Shrine when appearing as such The Fez is to be worn in its proper shape and without creasing or alteration; provided that it is permissible for Potentates, Past Potentates, Recorder and Divan Member as well as official uniformed organization to have their titles embroidered in small letter in gold or silver bullion or silk jewels on the front of the Fez beneath the emblem.

It shall be permissible to adorn the names of the Temple and the emblem with rhinestone jewels of size no larger than that known as No. 12 by the Fez makers."

"The use of any other WORDING or DEVICES than those mentioned in this Section and Article is prohibited."

It also points up the fact that the use of NUMERALS to date the year or years of service by the erstwhile appointee, making the Fez look like an obsolescent calendar, is prohibited.

Candidate for Recorder Frank Dyer

I am retired from the U. S, Postal Service after 40 years of service. Approximately 34 years was in the field of Human Resources, specifically in Labor Relations. 


