





Epictetus (55-135 CE) of Hierapolis is termed the "Free Man." As noted in last month's missive, he was a slave by birth. His name in Greek means, quite literally, "the acquired one." As a youth he was brutally treated and walked throughout his life with a limp. From the moment he was born, he knew how little control he had over his own physical life. He became a student of Musonius Rufus (see September 2021 essay) and a teacher of Stoic philosophy.

Epictetus was a disciple of virtue and selfimprovement. What is the point of virtue? he asked...a "well-flowing life" he posited. But he cautioned that our pursuits should be "done for their own sake", not for congratulations or "recognition."

A well-flowing life was facilitated by making certain decisions day in and day out. No matter our condition, we decide whether to focus upon "what is up to us" or upon things beyond our control. Our attitude for the day is the first decision we make. "So much is out of our hands. Yet so much remains within grasp..."

Each morning Epictetus had a dialogue with himself. He considered his progress. Observing that many people start their day looking out at the world, their careers, their activities, Epictetus started his day by looking in the mirror and holding himself accountable.

"What do I lack in order to achieve tranquility?" Where have I gone wrong? "What is to be done that has been left undone?" Have I been friendly, social, and caring?

(Brother Benjamin Franklin is said to have finished each day with a similar list of questions.)

For Epictetus, life was not about reading, memorization, impressive writings, or study. Such pursuits, though useful, did not render one virtuous. Action was what mattered. A well-flowing life required daily action and decision making aimed at becoming a "better person, a better thinker, a better citizen."

In Masonry, this process is called Work.

Masonry draws on a great deal of philosophy, history, and adventures of the intellect. But, at the end of the day, it is about our attitude, about the decisions we make or do not make, about the actions we take or refrain from taking. Epictetus may have approved of our Work.



Member **Education & Director of Work**

Christopher Houston "Kit" Carson (1809-1868) was a fur trapper, frontiersmen, and pioneer who helped settle the west.

He guided John Charles Fremont on

expeditions to map the Oregon Trail. In the 1850s, Carson was a Federal Indian Agent and strong advocate for Native Americans, traveling to Washington,

DC late in life as an advocate. He served in the Mexican American War and held the rank of Brigadier General for the Union during the War Between the States.


Born in Kentucky and reared in Missouri, he lived for a time around Santa Fe, New Mexico (when not on expeditions or trapping) and later settled in Taos, New Mexico and raised ten children.

Kit Carson was also a Freemason. During 1854, he was initi-

ated, passed, and raised at Montezuma Lodge No.

109 in the Santa Fe Territory. Subsequently, he was a founding

member of Bent Lodge No. 42 in Taos, chartered by the Grand Lodge of Missouri AF&AM. He served as both Junior and Senior Warden. but his journey to the East was interrupted by the War Between the States.

Bent Lodge No. 42, with the support of the Grand Lodge of New Mexico, purchased Carson's homestead in Taos in 1909. After a lengthy restoration period, it is now a non-profit historical museum.

The Museum includes a video presentation on Carson's life (produced by the History Channel,) an obligatory gift shop, and the restored homestead. It is designated a National Historic Landmark.

Visit the museum website at kitcarsonmuseum.org for more details.

When visiting the museum last October, inquiry was made as to the entrance fee. The proprietor gestured to a sign and replied "\$10; \$8 for seniors; kids are \$7." But he said with some

> relish, "if you are a Freemason and produce a dues card—there is no charge." The proprietor that day was the sitting Master of Bent Lodge. The Lodge owns the place and runs it. They cherish the legacy and fraternal contributions of Brother Kit Carson. So, Freemasons tour the Museum on their nickel.

A warm and fraternal conversation ensued. The whole experience was a positive and friendly statement about brotherhood and our Fraternity.
