November is our next ceremonial. Our goal is 58 new members for the year! We only need 25 for the November Ceremonial. That would be a 5% increase over 2018. It's never to early


to begin turning in petitions or viewing the NPD list and talking to someone who has been dropped from the rolls. Restorations is another way gaining new members.

The number three appears a lot in Freemasonry. We have 3 degrees, 3 principal officers, 3 Great Lights, 3 Lesser Lights, 3 moveable Jewels, 3 immovable jewels, 3 precious jewels of a Fellow Craft; a Fellow Craft receives wages of 3 types and has three Working Tools. There were 3 ruffians. 3 great pillars. We revere 3 senses of Human Nature above all others. There are 3 stages of human life. We give 3 knocks at the door. The Temple had three avenues of entry and exit. We revere three ancient orders of architecture. We are charged to inculcate 3 great duties. Our principal Tenets number three and we had three ancient Grand Masters.

Lots of threes. Yet there are only two working tools for an Entered Apprentice and only one for a Master Mason? Why are there not three tools for each degree?

Outside the US, Freemasonry includes three working tools for each degree.

In England and Scotland, the 3 working tools of the Entered Apprentice are the 24-inch gauge, common gavel and chisel. The explanation of the gavel suggests "the gavel teaches us that skill without exertion is of little avail, that labor is the lot of man; for the heart may conceive, and the head may devise in vain, if the hand be not prompted to execute the design." This interpretation seems very practical and designed to emphasize the virtue of hard work. It contrasts with our moral explanation that the Common Gavel serves to divest our hearts and consciences of the vices and superfluities of life.

The chisel is not used in Blue Lodges in the US. However, it appears in the Scottish and York Rites. The chisel symbolizes education, the means by which we improve ourselves. The association of the chisel with education is interesting, since education is often thought of as a cumulative endeavor, the accumulation knowledge and facts. The tool removes unnecessary rock from the usable stone, much as a plane remove excess wood. The idea that education

might chip away or remove the unnecessary merits attention. The chisel is emblematical of education by elimination, not accumulation.

The three working tools of Master Mason outside the US are the compasses, skirret and pencil. The compass has significance in our Entered Apprentice degree as a Great Light. In the English ritual, the compasses allude to Justice. Their ritual suggests that "the compasses reminds us of God's unerring and impartial, justice, Who, having defined for our instruction the limits of good and evil, will reward or punish as we have obeyed or disregarded His Divine commands...should we fail to subdue our passions we will be judged for it, even if we escape earthly punishment."

The skirret is a tool to be used in laying a foundation. It is a spool of thread on a handle. The loose end of the thread has a loop or ring to attach to a center pin or stake. The thread is unwound and kept taut. Once the desired length is reached, a piece of chalk is used to the mark the foundation line. In modern times, it would be called a chalk line. It serves a similar purpose as the ruler does for drawing a straight line on a piece of paper.

The skirret alludes to that straight and undeviating line of conduct laid down for our reflection in the Volume of Sacred Law. When we consider that the Volumes used by Freemasonry, whether it be the Hebrew Bible, the Christian Bible, the Koran or writings of the Hindus, we recognize that they were written years ago, in cultures and contexts different from contemporary times. Yet each is a rule and guide to our faith and practice.

The third working tool of a Master Mason outside the US is the pencil. The Canadian ritual suggests "the pencil teaches us that all our works and actions are not only observed, but recorded by the Supreme Grand Master, to whom we must render an account of our conduct."

If we look at the pencil more literally, it, like the compasses and skirret, is a tool of planning. The compasses and pencil are used to draw designs upon the Trestle Board and the skirret helps the Master prepare the ground for the foundation.

This planning must be done before the Apprentice descends into the quarry with his 24-inch gauge, gavel and chisel to prepare stones and before the Fellow Craft tries the first stone with his square.

As we leave the Northeast Corner to build our spiritual Temple, we may reflect upon the necessity of having a full complement of working tools. Perhaps we need three for each of the different stages of life.

We prepare ourselves with the gavel, chisel and 24inch gauge. We try our work, we try ourselves, by the plumb, level and square. We plan our journey and our building with the pencil, skirret and compasses. We build and finish our work with the use of the trowel.

The Valley of Tampa regularly meets at its Center in Tampa on the 2nd Monday of each month. Dinner is served at 5:45 PM and the regular meeting starts at 7:00 PM. At our August 12th meeting the 8th degree, Intendant of the Building, will be conferred at 6:10 PM, after dinner and before the meeting. Right Worshipful William Sundquist 32nd degree KCCH will present a program at the meeting.
