There is nothing like a good story. Stories entertain and relax us, or they challenge us. They can be intense mysteries or imaginative fantasies. Sometimes stories are a comedy, sometimes a tragedy. But they are always, in some way, instructive. We learn as much from reading Aesop's fables as from War and Peace. A well-told story beats a textbook every time.

Freemasonry tells a good story, one about personal growth, self-reflection; about man's pursuit of his proper role in the world and his relationship with other people and with Deity.

Think about it. Every degree is story. Each involves a traveler on a quest, a journey. He is searching for something or some place. Sometimes the degree ends with a destination having been reached, like when we ascend to the highest step of the winding stairs. Sometimes it concludes when a new, enlightening thought has entered our mind. Sometimes a degree ends with some accomplishment or achievement, sometimes with a tragic event.

But Freemasonry's stories always end with a lesson, some instruction. That instruction is often a question, such as, what do I do now? Now that I have completed a degree, how should my life change, how should my conduct be modified? (Sometimes the question is simply: what just happened to me? A lifetime can be spent trying to figure out "what just happened to me" in the second section of the Master Mason degree.)

The Scottish Rite continues the story (stories) begun in the Symbolic Lodge. For example, the Eighth Degree, Intendant of the Building, tells a story about the selection of the successor(s) to Hiram Abiff. We were left hanging at the end for Master Mason. The Hiramic Legend doesn't tell us anything about the Temple's completion or who

assumed leadership after our Grand Master was gone.

The Eighth Degree continues the story started in the Third Degree and in doing so offers some valuable things to think about. It includes ideas about succession planning, leadership, teaching, the importance of exemplary conduct, cultural continuity and even some suggestions about the proper relationship of labor and management. The Eighth Degree is another good Masonic story replete with concepts and lessons to contemplate.

The degrees of the Symbolic Lodge tell a good story. Those of the Scottish Rite make for good sequels. Ah! We should see them regularly.

The Eighth Degree will next be conferred on August 9, 2021 at 6:10 PM, before the regular monthly meeting.

The Scottish Rite meets at its Center in Tampa on the 2nd Monday of each month at 7:00 PM, preceded by a 5:45 PM dinner. The Scottish Rite's degrees will next be conferred on April 10th and 17th, 2021. Petitions are available at http:// tampascottishrite.org.

The September meeting came to order at P.M. on September 22nd with 13 Nobles in attendance. The Club was pleased to welcome visitor James Vaughn from Tampa Bay Lodge #252 and RW Glen Bishop, JGW of the GL of Florida and RW Rick Wendling, DI of the 18th Masonic District. The Club recognized the passing of MW Jim Durham, Jr., PGM.

The Treasurer's Report was presented and accepted. SANDS representative D. Mertz reported that no articles have been released because of the Club's very limited activities (in a subsequent conversation it was agreed that this condensation of the Meeting Minutes would be published.) Putting for a Purpose Event – no information is available at this time. East-West Shrine Game tentatively scheduled for 1.23.2021. It was agreed that the Club will proceed with the assumption that the game will be held and that the PSC fundraiser will occur and that the event sub-committee will proceed with arrangements including the purchase a new pop-up tent. PSC Christmas Party - this event scheduled for 12.22 has been cancelled. It was agreed that the Club will have a member only December meeting in place of the Christmas party on 12.15 at a location to be determined. PSC future meeting location - future locations will be selected on a monthly basis. The October meeting will be at Noble Rick Wendling's home. Valspar Golf Tournament Fundraiser – is scheduled for April 29 - May 2, 2021. The SMMA will be manning the largest hospitality tent at the event. If a Saturday night concert is scheduled offering the opportunity for a fundraiser as has been the case in the past the PSC will man that tent as a fund-raiser.

The unit has been cleaned out and closed. Members are encouraged to retrieve their belongings from Noble Rick Wendling. PSC has selected new Club shirts in a light blue shirt configuration (similar to a Columbia fishing shirt) for purchase. Cost including name personalization is \$50. Orders can be placed through Noble Club President Glen Bishop. The PSC will pursue an opportunity to become the cigar supplier at the new Palm River Oasis as a fundraiser. Noble Rick Wendling will donate a humidor suitable for dispensing the cigars and will determine a sourcing/delivery and pricing structure that will be a win-win for both PSC and Egypt Shrine. The possibility of PSC selling cigars at the Grand Lodge was also discussed and will be investigated. Because of the inability of PSC to hold our normal fundraisers, Club members agreed to increase the annual dues to \$40 subject to a ballot approval at the October PSC meeting. Members agreed to donate \$100 to the SMMA Treasure Chest. Members agreed to donate \$225 to Star Lodge for their Car Show trophies. Each awarded trophy will contain "donated by PSC" mention. It was also agreed that the PSC will host a cigar sales booth fundraiser at the event scheduled for 11.15.2020 from 11AM-3PM at Star Lodge. PSC agreed to donate \$50 to Anclote Chapter DeMolay, Largo Assembly Rainbow Girls - Star Lodge, and Jobs Daughters Bethel - Nitram Lodge. The following slate of officers were placed in nomination for next year: President - Noble Rick Wendling, Vice President – Noble Ron Martin, Secretary – Noble Chas Jordan, Treasurer – Noble Bill Sundquist and Director – Noble Duane Mertz.





Our new Unit room (shared with the Keystone Kops) is in the planning process. El Hefe Jeremy Knight has a committee with a couple Kops, and we've already secured chairs and the flooring. We envision a first class Unit Room. We believe in good hospitality for members and guests, and are dedicated to achieving the highest honors on the competition field.
