The upcoming national election, with its endless television commercials, prerecorded telephone calls, debates and campaign mailers evokes relief that Freemasonry proscribes the discussion of politics in open Lodge.

Nonetheless, as discussed in the January 2015 edition, our ancient brethren encouraged us to be informed citizens and to actively participate in our own governance. That missive noted two examples: Past Grand Masters Thomas Brown and Albert W. Gilchrist also served as Governors of Florida.

Several Scottish Rite degrees direct our attention to matters of governance and politics and to our proper role in the process.

The 4th, 5th and 6th degrees can be interpreted as emphasizing the importance of an educated, enlightened citizenry. An independent judiciary is a theme in the 7th degree. An orderly economic system is highlighted in the 8th degree. The functions of Upper and Lower legislative bodies are hinted at in the 9th and 10th, as is freedom of the press; trial by jury appears in the 11th and the importance of the Chief Executive is alluded to in the 12th. The 13th degree includes an oration suggesting that a "mixed constitution" will foster the preservation of liberty."

These degrees seem to frame our role in civic life and encourage our engagement.

Whatever our level of interest in (or frustration with) politics might be, as men, Masons and citizens, we have a duty at least be an "educated, enlightened" citizen.

Marcus Cicero (106-43 BCE) a Roman philosopher and statesman, instructed his son on the realm of politics in a letter that became a classic book, On Obligations.

Recalling an analogy found in Book VI of Plato's Republic (beginning at line 488, if you're interested),

Cicero suggests that political candidates and wannabe leaders are like a group of inexperienced sailors, each vying to seize the helm of a ship. Each man thinks that he ought to steer, though he has never performed the art. Unable to describe their terms of apprenticeship for sailing and navigation, their qualifications for leading, the sailors attack each other and endeavor to throw each other overboard. The process can result in a rudderless, aimless, drifting ship.

As for the qualified citizen seeking office, "canvassing and scrambling for office is an utterly wretched business."

Although Cicero describes a dismal process to his son. He urges his son not to withdraw, but to engage. As a citizen, he must not show bitter anger towards adversaries. Rebukes and disagreements must be free of insult. He should be noble, exemplary in conduct, conciliatory and forgiving. "Those who live in free societies where there is equality before the law should make a habit of affability and maintain a high level of tolerance."

Sounds Masonic, doesn't it? Moral conduct, subdued passions, open-mindedness, tolerance, kindness, politeness.

As Masons maybe we can set a good example for our fellow citizens. Certainly, we can do better than the sailors.

The Valley of Tampa regularly meets at its Center in Tampa on the 2nd Monday of each month at 7:00 PM, preceded by a 5:45 PM dinner. Our annual Remembrance and Renewal ceremony, commemorating Brothers who passed to the Great Lodge, will be conducted on April 13th. Casey Fletcher is the sitting Master of Tuscan Lodge No. 6 in Bartow, Florida. He notes that a member of his Lodge, Spessard L. Holland 330, was Governor of Florida and a US Senator. He set a good example.


normally about 150 children, plus teachers and aids.

We will be Ushering the Friday Egypt Circus again this year and look forward to being part of the Circus. Good luck to our two clowns, Nibble & Peep.


Future is the New Temple, cant wait for Grand Opening.




I've written many times telling you about other Pharaohs. Today, I'm going to tell you about me!

Have you ever taken the time to look at the back of a dollar bill? It should remind us of the freedoms we enjoy as Americans. The "Great Seal" on the left and the Latin words tell us a new nation has begun as it emerges from a revolution. Another quotation around the top of the pyramid says "He (God) has favored our undertaking." The pyramid suggests something of Egypt slavery. At the bottom is a "seeing eye" - a symbol of God's watch over a new land of freedom. There are thirteen blocks of the pyramid to correspond to the thirteen original colonies.

On the right hand side is a floral medallion with an eagle on top. Thirteen stars can be seen and the eagle is a replica of the America flag with a vertical row of thirteen stripes emblematic of the thirteen colonies.

The eagle once considered the symbol of America holds an olive branch in one of its talons, the symbol of peace. The other talon holds either arrows or sheaves of wheat, symbols of military preparedness or growing industry. Around the head of the eagle is written "E Pluribus Unum" meaning out of many one nation. At the center are the words "In God We Trust" which are words not written by chance.






