


The Potentate's Message

The AASR Masonic Digest has included a series of missives on Stoic philosophy, its ancient advocates, and its potential influence upon our ancient Masonic brethren in the development of our masonic work. The missives have highlighted Epictetus (55-135 CE) of Hierapolis as prominent among the stoic teachers.

This missive will (might) wrap up the Stoic series with the application of stoic concepts in more modern times.

James Stockdale (1923-2005) was a Naval aviator during the Vietnam war. Shot down, he was a prisoner of war for over seven years and was the highest-ranking officer at the Hanoi Hilton.

Well studied in philosophy at Stanford prior to his captivity, Stockdale credited stoic philosophy with helping him cope with and survive his ordeals

as a prisoner of war. He reported arming himself with stoic teaching as he parachuted down, "I am leaving the world of technology and entering the world of Epictetus." He well knew his situation would be beyond his control, but he knew from stoicism that his survival could be influenced by the decisions he could make.

Stockdale focused on what (little) he could control, notably his attitude. The POWs followed Stockdale's leadership and emulated determination, persistence, and example. For this leadership he was later awarded the Medal of Honor.

He later served as the president of the Navy War College 1977-1979. During this tenure, Stockdale developed an elective course on philosophy and ethics – it is said to be the most popular elective course among the officers.

Charlie Plumb (1942-), also a naval aviator, was a POW with Stockdale for about five years and became the chief communicator at the Hilton (how they communicated is a story by itself).

Upon his capture and after several days of torture, completely distraught, dispirited, exhausted, perhaps broken, (Plumb's description) he received a message from Stockdale – "you have the prisoner's disease." The meaning was later explained, "you are indeed a captive. Whether you are a prisoner or not, is up to you." It was Plumb's introduction to stoicism. He was a captive - but he came to learn he was a prisoner only if he decided to be.

Their fate beyond their control, Stockdale, Plumb and all the POWs learned, in the words of Epictetus, to "persist" and "resist," to focus upon what was within their grasp and to accept what was not.

Stories of Stockdale, Plumb and the other POWS are dramatic. But these men's emulation of stoic teaching, Epictetus's in particular, remind us that the writings of Greco-Roman philosophers and our ancient Masonic brethren should not be relegated to entertainment value. They should be studied for their practical and relevant lessons for approaching our daily lives, however undramatic our lives may be.

Our masonic work contains a good syllabus and script for living.

Comment: much about Stockdale's stoicism was learned while attending a civilian conference at the Navy War College several years ago. The writer was also fortunate to meet Plumb (on a different occasion) and converse privately about Stockdale, stoicism, and Epictetus. This writer mostly listened.

Challenges and may you explore new worlds in your Enterprise. Beam me up.


