The Fellow Craft degree highlights the five human senses before proceeding to a discussion of the seven liberal arts and sciences. The first three of each of these lists appear to be related and might be paired.

The first three arts and sciences, grammar, rhetoric and logic, address how we communicate with others and express ourselves. The importance of each is welldescribed in the Lecture. Hearing, seeing and feeling, are the natural senses by which we effectuate our expressions.

We hear arguments and can understand them if they are grammatically sufficient. Seeing allows us to judge the sincerity of the speaker's rhetoric. Feeling (as in perceiving) allows us to judge whether the argument is sound, logical and reasonable.

Freemasonry highlights these tools and pairs them for our use. But they are just tools.

The Greek stoic Epictetus (55-135) provides context for the proper and effective use of these tools. And he reminds us that they are but tools. Sight and hearing, he submits, "have been appointed to be slaves and subordinate" to another human faculty. They are but tools for the wise and virtuous man. "An eye, when open, has no option but to see." The decision of what to look at or to observe rests with the wisdom and virtue of the beholder.

The "faculty of expression and arranging words (grammar and rhetoric) ...does nothing more than dress up and organize... a given topic, the way a hairdresser arranges hair. But whether to speak at all or remain silent" is the province of good judgment and of the will.

Epictetus asserted the greatest human sense or element was that of the will. The will to pursue truth, wisdom and knowledge, the will to employ good judgment and act virtuously.

The will controls "speech, as well as every other faculty, great and small." Is there any faculty stronger, he asks? "What can obstruct the will? Nothing external...which is why virtue applies to it alone."

Perhaps here is an intersection with Freemasonry and our life journey. While learning to well-employ our senses and develop our communication skills, we must frame our lives to put them to good use. That requires knowledge and


virtue. It requires will-power.

It was our "will" as Entered Apprentices to search for knowledge and Truth; to learn virtuous habits and right conduct. Our search and journey continue(s) through the Symbolic Lodge and the Scottish Rite.

The human senses and arts and sciences are but our tools to assist us in our travels. We must have the will to use them wisely. Epictetus encourages us.

The Scottish Rite's degrees will next be conferred May 18 and 19, 2019. Petitions are available at http:// tampascottishrite.org. The Rite meets the second Monday of each month at 7:00 PM, preceded by a dinner at 5:45 PM. At the April 8th meeting, we will honor Brethren who passed to the Celestial Lodge during the past year in a Ceremony of Remembrance and Renewal.


In February, March and again in April our Ladies were invited to a Mimosa gathering prior to lunch and during the start of our Regular Meeting. We all enjoyed the meal following.

The Ladies are invited to our March meeting, as we will have a guest speaker. Hopefully we can fill the room.


A special thanks to the Provost Guard Unit for allowing other clubs to ride on their float.

Proposed Bylaw Change

Bylaws of Shriners International Read:

ARTICLE 24

Temple Meetings & Ceremonials

§ 324.1 Stated Meetings.

- (a) Frequency. Every temple must hold a stated meeting at least once in each calendar quarter. The Imperial Potentate may grant a special dispensation to change the date of any stated meeting.
- (b) Annual Meeting Date and Location. The first stated meeting of each calendar year must be held in January at the location of the temple and it is the annual meeting. The Imperial Potentate may grant a special dispensation to change the location of the annual meeting. Amend. 2015

Egypt Shriners Bylaws Currently Read:

- §3.1 Stated Meetings. A stated meeting shall be held on the second Wednesday of each month (except the Annual Meeting). The exact hour of all meetings, including the annual meeting, shall be designated by the Potentate.
 - (a) Annual Meeting. The annual meeting shall be held on the second Saturday in January.

Proposed change:

Therefore Be it Resolved that Egypt Shriners Bylaws §3.1 Be Amended to Read:

- §3.1 Stated Meetings. A stated meeting shall be held monthly with the date of the meeting to be designated by the Potentate. The exact hour of all meetings, including the annual meeting, shall be designated by the Potentate.
 - (a) No Change.

Purpose: In the past, Egypt Shriners Stated Meetings have been rescheduled for different reasons, e.g., due to the timing of an Imperial Session or Potentate's trip. This scheduling change requires the dispensation by the Imperial Potentate. Changing this Bylaw would give the sitting Potentate the flexibility, if desired, to move the December stated meeting to whatever day that would facilitate the election of officers.

Proposed Bylaw Change

Bylaws of Shriners International Read:

Article 25

Officers; Their Election or Appointment

§ 325.4 When Elected. Each temple must elect its officers and representatives at its annual meeting in January unless its bylaws allow the election to occur at the temple's stated meeting in December.

Egypt Shriners Bylaws Currently Read:

§4.3 Election and Appointment. The election and appointment of officers are governed by the bylaws of Shriners International.

Proposed change:

Therefore Be it Resolved that Egypt Shriners Bylaws §4.3 be Amended to Read:

§4.3 Election and Appointment. The election and appointment of officers are governed by the bylaws of Shriners International and shall take place at the December stated meeting.

Purpose: Changing this Bylaw would bring Egypt Shriners in line with all other temples in Florida who already vote in December. This will allow the Divan-elect, the necessary time to address the obligations of their newly elected position: The Oriental Guide-Elect additional time to better plan the Showmen Expo; and the Potentate-Elect to mail invitations for the Potentate's Ball. He presently has about 5 weeks to mail his invitations. This often gives our guests insufficient time to secure a room at the host hotel because of the hotel's set deadlines.

The schedule for the Annual Meeting would stay the same- Annual Meeting, lunch, Installation of Officers and post-party.
