Scottish Rite News

The Scholastic period (1100-1700 CE) concerned itself with articulating and defending religious dogma in an increasingly pluralistic context. Scholasticism is not so much a philosophy or a theology as a method of learning. Scholastic thought is known for rigorous conceptual analysis and careful distinctions. It began as an attempt to reconcile Christian theology with the philosophy of classical and late antiquity, especially with that of Aristotle (384-322 BCE).

Thomas Aquinas (1225-1274 CE), a scholastic philosopher, among other distinctions, considered how to understand the natural phenomenon surrounding us. What are the causes and purposes of the world around us?

He suggested, channeling Aristotle, that four causes of things exist: a material cause, a formal cause, an efficient cause, and a final cause.

As an example, the material cause of a cat is that it is made of flesh as opposed to stone. Its formal cause are the qualities and behavior we associate with a cat, whiskers, a tail, fur and purring, for example. Its efficient cause was its parents, a male and female cat. Its final cause is its purpose: devouring mice and making other cats (and ignoring its owner).

When Aristotle and Aquinas looked at the world, they saw a Big Picture of the universe. Everything had cause(s) and purpose(s). The Big Picture included an Author, or as we say, an Architect.

Enter the "Age of Enlightenment" period, a/k/a, the Age of Reason. This was a time of intellectual and philosophical activity that dominated ideas in Europe during the 18th century around the possible birth of Freemasonry as we know it.

The Enlightenment period focused more on the Small Picture. It focused on understanding the material and efficient cause of things. Such a pursuit was not without merit. Great effort was directed "to improve our material conditions – to cure diseases, curb natural disasters, harness natural forces, develop new technologies..."

Fathers of modern science, such as Francis Bacon (1561-1626) and Rene Descartes (1596-1650) led the way on narrowing Scholastic-period thinking to material and efficient causes (and we can be grateful for their contributions).

Yet something is missing. The Enlightenment focused on details, not upon purposes.

For the Scholastic thinker or philosopher, knowledge was not just about the material, formal or efficient causes of the Enlightenment thinker; it was about final causes. It was about wisdom; it was about meaning and purposes and duty. Why are we here? What are we here to do?

Enter Freemasonry (if only on the sidelines). Though the fraternity was likely birthed, in its present form, during the Enlightenment, it still espouses Scholastic-period thinking. It asserts we are here for a purpose and have a duty to discover and complete that purpose. That purpose, and its Author, are something greater than ourselves. Freemasonry asserts we are here for a final cause, to do good and improve our world.

The Enlightenment and its emphasis on reason allows us to attain progress in our material lives. However, a world without final causes, a purpose, a mission, a duty or statement of "what we are here to do," or the attainment of Light, Wisdom and Truth, is hard to fathom.

Freemasonry is true to the Scholastic notion of "final" causes. We have a duty. We have a purpose. Freemasonry considers the Big Picture.

The Scottish Rite's degrees will be conferred on October 26th and 27th. Petitions are available at <http://tampascottishrite.org>.

The Rite meets the second Monday of each month at 7:00 PM, preceded by a dinner at 5:45 PM. At our June meeting, we will celebrate Flag Day. This is an open meeting; visitors are welcome.

Egypt Shriners Proposed Bylaw Change

Whereas, the Bylaws of Shriners International Read:

ARTICLE 24

Temple Meetings & Ceremonials

§ 324.1 Stated Meetings.

(a) Frequency. Every temple must hold a stated meeting at least once in each calendar quarter. The Imperial Potentate may grant a special dispensation to change the date of any stated meeting.

(b) Annual Meeting Date and Location. The first stated meeting of each calendar year must be held in January at the location of the temple and it is the annual meeting. The Imperial Potentate may grant a special dispensation to change the location of the annual meeting. Amend. 2015;

and

Whereas, the Bylaws of Egypt Shriners Currently Read:

§3.1 Stated Meetings. A stated meeting shall be held on the second Wednesday of each month (except the Annual Meeting). The exact hour of all meetings, including the annual meeting, shall be designated by the Potentate.

(a) Annual Meeting. The annual meeting shall be held on the second Saturday in January.

Proposed change:

Therefore, Be it Resolved that Egypt Shriners Bylaws §3.1 Be Amended to Read:

§3.1 Stated Meetings. A stated meeting shall be held monthly with the date of the meeting to be designated by the Potentate (except the Annual Meeting). The exact hour of all meetings, including the annual meeting, shall be designated by the Potentate.

(a) No Change.

Effect of the Resolution: In the past, Egypt Shriners Stated Meetings have needed to be rescheduled for different reasons, e.g., due to the timing of an Imperial Session or a Potentate's trip. This scheduling change requires the dispensation by the Imperial Potentate. Changing this Bylaw would give the sitting Potentate the **flexibility, if desired**, to move the December Stated meeting to whatever day that would facilitate the election of officers.

Egypt Shriners Proposed Bylaw Change

Whereas, the Bylaws of Shriners International Read:

Article 25 Officers; Their Election or Appointment

§ 325.4 When Elected. Each temple must elect its officers and representatives at its annual meeting in January unless its bylaws allow the election to occur at the temple's stated meeting in December;

and

Whereas, the Bylaws of Egypt Shriners Currently Read:

§4.3 Election and Appointment. The election and appointment of officers are governed by the bylaws of Shriners International.

Proposed change:

Therefore, Be it Resolved that Egypt Shriners Bylaws §4.3 be Amended to Read:

§4.3 Election and Appointment. The election and appointment of officers are governed by the bylaws of Shriners International **and shall take place at the December stated meeting.**

Effect of the Resolution: Changing this Bylaw would bring Egypt Shriners in line with all other temples in Florida who already vote in December. This will allow the Divan-elect, the necessary time to address the obligations of their newly elected positions: The Oriental Guide-Elect additional time to better plan the Showmen Expo; and the Potentate-Elect to mail invitations for the Potentate's Ball. He presently has about 5 weeks to mail his invitations. This often gives our guests insufficient time to secure a room at the host hotel because of the hotel's own set deadlines.
