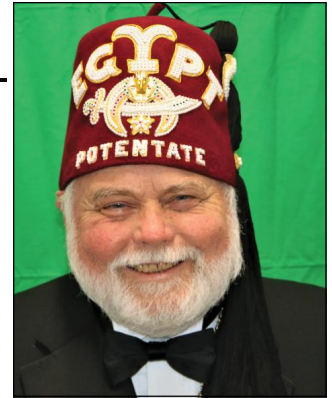

Why a Chaplain at Egypt Shrine?

Here at the Egypt Shrine, we are committed to responding to each Temple referral in a timely manner and visiting the sick on a regular basis, yet, many times, we are not aware of your needs. If you or someone in your family would call The Egypt office, we will gladly respond to you.

I am an ordained minister and have been a Chaplain for several organizations over the years. Each of these organization required very different types of support. Both Jeff Lake and I have been professionally trained to not only open and close the meetings, but to bring the Masonic concept of spirituality to our meetings, to provide ministry to and for the members, and to act as a moral conscience for our organization. We care and offer a supporting role between our Fraternity, its members, and their families, doing so with dignity, concern, and a caring heart. We provide an attentive ear and confidentially in relationships, all the while working under the direction of our Illustrious Potentate. We provide spiritual and emotional care to our Brethren and their family, to persons of all faiths, and spiritualities. As Chaplains, we make ourselves available to walk beside the person on their journey, both in times of struggle and times in joy. Illnesses can be a painful and isolating experience, full of uncertain ties and losses. As Chaplains, we seek to understand and participate, taking into consideration the person's frame of reference. We seek to empower people to creatively encounter their situations with possibilities for healing and renewal. Although tragedy and death are not easy for Chaplains, we bring experience, knowledge, training, and skills to bear. The Chaplain can make an important difference in the lives of the people they touch. In the same way we share in the suffering with our members, we share in the joys, the births, weddings, graduations, and the like.

In closing, as you can now understand, we have a great and important position here at the Egypt Shrine; a position that both Jeff and I heartedly share and embrace. Since Jeff resides in Lakeland and I in Dunedin, we are more equipped than ever to cover the needs of our members. Jeff and I are here to assist our community and as more members feel comfortable to reach out, that would bring us great pleasure.

Irony is a suitable characterization of our Masonic journey.

Every initiate begins with the reasonable expectation, reinforced by the Fraternity, that secret knowledge, a mystery, or information long hidden from the profane will be obtained. How ironic it is to arrive at the milepost of the third degree only to learn that the "secret" cannot be revealed because it is lost. Not just simply misplaced in some dusty, dark apartment beneath the ground within a small wooden chest or coffer, but lost, "perhaps, forever lost!" Answers had been sought and, ironically, only symbols, allegories, and metaphors were received. This was not expected.

The irony continues. We must grapple with the Lost Word. What is it? Really? Is it literally a word? Or is it a state of mind, a process, or some allusion to an intellectual or spiritual condition? The Hiram Legend offers only the mythical explanation that it was a word of recognition for the travelling Master Mason's economic benefit and convenience. This explanation is easily dismissed by thoughtful Masons and explicitly dismissed in the 13th degree, Royal Arch of Solomon. If it were literally so, i.e., merely a word of recognition, knowing it would be but a weak ending to an otherwise good story. It must mean something, but the ritual does not tell us.

The discovery of the Lost Word is portrayed in the order of the Holy Royal Arch Mason in York Rite Masonry. Similarly, a Lost Word, True Word, and Real Word are offered in the Scottish Rite's 14th, 18th and 32nd degrees, respectively. To conclude from any of these rituals that, "oh, that is what the lost word is" may induce us to become settled and satisfied, to conclude we have the "secret." If knowing such a Word impedes our continual search, we may have missed the point. If receiving the (a) Word seems to be an end point or a final destination of our journey, better it might be that it remains lost.

We commenced a journey to obtain a secret and we come to learn that our journey is a metaphorical one, a continuous one, a journey conducted with a sense of duty and obligation. We know not our destination. We learn only to keep searching.

How ironic. The irony is not without intent and purpose.

Shriners International

-  In 2022, the Shriners International fraternity and the Shriners Hospitals for Children health care system celebrate major milestones.
-  Shriners International is celebrating the 150th anniversary of its founding, which was on September 26, 1872.
-  Shriners Hospitals for Children is celebrating the 100th anniversary of its founding, on September 16, 1922.
-  Shriners International was founded in New York City in 1872 by a group of fun-loving Masons. Master Masons are eligible for membership in the organization, which is based on the fundamentals of Masonry but with the added elements of fun and fellowship.
-  Created by Walter M. Fleming, M.D., and actor William J. "Billy" Florence using a Near-east theme that was in vogue at the time, the fraternity was originally named the Ancient Arabic Order of the Nobles of the Mystic Shrine. It still uses Near-eastern symbols, most distinctively the red fez.
-  Now known as Shriners International, the fraternity has nearly 200,000 members, and Shriners can be found on six continents. Shriners are known for their good humor, and they love spending time with others who share their interests, whether it be performing in parades or bands, connecting via Zoom for a technology unit or getting together to ride motorcycles, make barbecue or craft beer. The bond of brotherhood that Shriners enjoy also helps them develop personal and professional skills such as communications and leadership.
-  In addition to fun and fellowship, Shriners value serving their communities in ways large and small. From hosting charity events to volunteering their time to supporting their official philanthropy, the red-fezzed Shriners are among the most generous and caring men you will ever meet.

Shriners Hospitals for Children

-  Members of Shriners International have always shared a common desire to help those in need. Even in the earliest years of the fraternity, nobles aided victims of catastrophic events and served those less fortunate in their local communities, exhibiting a generous spirit beyond the group's mission of fun and fellowship.
-  In the late 1910s, Shriners International took steps to formalize a philanthropic endeavor members could call their own. In 1922, the first Shriners Hospitals for Children opened, in Shreveport, Louisiana, to serve children with orthopedic conditions, particularly those caused by the polio epidemic happening at the time.
-  What began as a single hospital is now a unique health care system with locations across the United States, as well as in Mexico and Canada. Outreach programs help the system reach children around the world.
-  Today, the health care system, often known as Shriners Children's, offers care for a range of orthopedic issues, as well as care for burn injuries, craniofacial conditions, spine care and spinal cord injuries, colorectal and gastrointestinal care, and sports medicine. Our experienced, innovative and dedicated teams work together to provide treatment to help each patient meet their goals and reach their full potential.
-  Since 1922, Shriners Hospitals for Children has improved the lives of more than 1.5 million children.
-  The health care system's three-part mission has one goal: to change and improve lives. We do this by caring for our patients, conducting research to gain knowledge and develop new treatments, and providing educational opportunities for physicians and other health care professionals.
-  The health care professionals of Shriners Hospitals for Children have been responsible for many pioneering treatments over the years, including, but not limited to, innovative treatment for burn injuries, rehabilitative care of kids with spinal cord injuries and new treatments for scoliosis (curvature of the spine) such as vertebral body tethering.
-  Shriners Hospitals for Children looks forward to its next 100 years of caring for children and their families.

Masonic and Shrine Dignitary bricks are placed East

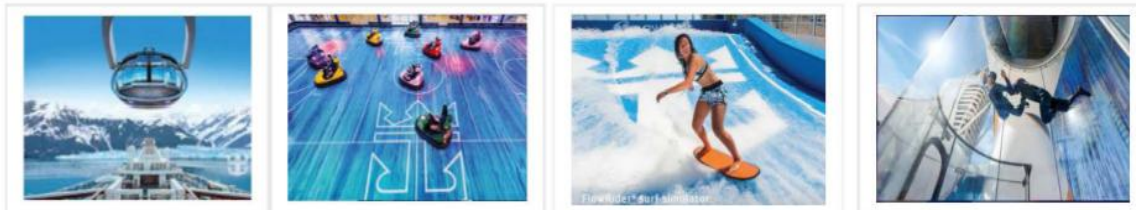
